In the framework of non-degree (exchange and freemover) programmes a student can spend 1 or 2 semesters at SPbU taking courses or conducting a research.

Non-degree programmes are available on tuition-free (exchange) basis to the students of SPbU partner universities or on fee-paying (freemover) basis to all applicants.

Non-degree students can take SPbU courses up to 30 ECTS (on undergraduate (Bachelor) and graduate (Master) levels) or conduct a research under the supervision of SPbU scientific advisor (on graduate (Master) and postgraduate (PhD) levels).

Exchange students can be enrolled in SPbU only if their chosen language of instruction level is confirmed not lower than B2 in accordance with the European Language Level Self Assessment Grid.

Exception is made for the students who apply to fulltime Russian language course for foreign students. It is available for students with any level of Russian language proficiency.
