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Ref.: Coverage of treatment costs during international business trips

Compensa Towarzystwo Ubezpieczeń S.A. VIG confirms that the basic scope of insurance coverage of the Group Insurance for the Jagiellonian University was extended to the costs incurred due to the treatment of SARS-CoV-2 (Covid-19) disease. This modification was not present in General Terms of Insurance Compensa Voyage, approved by Compensa TU S.A. VIG Board Resolution of 6 February 2017, no. 4/02/2017.

This scope of insurance coverage was extended to the following limits:

- 1) Since the day of signing the Annex to Agreement until the moment the SARS-CoV-2/Covid-19 vaccinations are generally available – up to the sum of EUR 50,000 for medical expenses (KL – koszty leczenia) occurred on the area of the United States, Canada, Australia, New Zealand and the area of the World – the territories of all countries of the world.
- 2) From the moment the vaccinations are available:
  - a) limit of treatment costs incurred due to the SARS-CoV-2/Covid-19 disease – up to the sum of EUR 5,000
  - b) limit of treatment costs incurred due to the SARS-CoV-2/Covid-19 disease – up to the sum insured of the treatment costs specified in the policy but not more than up to EUR 50,000 provided that the Insured, who is travelling abroad, shall be inoculated against SARS-CoV-2/Covid-19 disease with a vaccine available in Poland (provided that the vaccine is available without any administrative limitations and on the market. This scope of insurance coverage shall not apply to those Insured to whom the COVID-19 vaccine cannot be administered in accordance with the manufacturer's indications or pharmacovigilance's indications).
